It was announced that Alan Wassilak will be guest of honor at The Oceanside Magic Invitational, April 11 on Cape Cod.


Gil Stubbs provided a link to all of his shows on Wellesley Cable Television. http://www.wellesleymedia.org/Stubbs-magic-show.html.
