Ring 122 October Meeting Report

Alan Wassilak spoke to past president Ann Fields' daughter. Ann turned 90 this summer and, to date, is the only female Ring 122 president! The current plan is to hold a meeting with a few people at her house and while on a Zoom link to honor her past service.

In other news, Ryan will book our first in-person meetings this January, February, and March at the Watertown Library in one of their free meeting rooms! We will continue to host the meeting via Zoom, but members that can and wish to meet in person and welcome.

With the business meeting done, we began the Halloween magic! **Debbie O'Carroll** presented a Halloween Book Box magic idea using a Halloween-themed book box available from Michael's Art Supply Stores. Using black fabric and gaffing tape, she produced a silk display with the name of one of her regular clients displayed as each letter in individual silks. This was quite a sight since the client name was over 18 characters long! She uses a fabric pen to write each letter on a different colored silk. Debbie suggested that a Whitman's Candy box would work as a box (something **Ray Goulet** once suggested to her.) Members suggested Debbie sends a parade feature to the Linking Ring.

Next, **Daniel Barbas** presented a mentalist effect based on a teen horror movie. He correctly predicted which of 8 people survived. Daniel mentioned that he is working on a plan to hold a séance and solicited ideas from members. **Jim Rainho** suggested a spirit slate routine. Jim also added to not do a card trick as it would be too magic-like and not right for a séance.

Then Ryan Lally discussed a routine using a Card Spider magic trick. Ryan is looking for help with the thread set up. This is an effect from Martins Magic Collection and we saw a video of the effect being done. A member suggested a method for Ryan to try.

Ring 122 Director **Rob Kinslow** presented his classic wooden finger chopper. Dan Bybell presented a hand chopper story that really scared his family it looked so real!

After a few stories of flame effects gone wrong, including one by a then- young Jim Rainho which ended up with second degree burns to his arm(!), we all called it a night.
